UCAS TARIFF POINTS FOR UNIVERSITY

UCAS Tariff points are being used by some universities and colleges to set their entry requirements and to make offers. Instead of asking for grades, a university might express the offer as a number of points. For courses starting from September 2017, a new Tariff will be in place. This means that the **NEW Tariff Points** for qualifications will be:

A Level

A* - 56 points

A - 48 points

B - 40 points

C - 32 points

D - 24 points

E - 16 points

BTEC Subsidiary Diploma

Distinction* - 56 points

Distinction - 48 points

Merit - 32 points

Pass - 16 points

AS Level

A - 20 points B - 16 points C - 12 points D - 10 points E - 6 points
