Length of Examination	1 hour and 30 mins
Question Paper	Completion of the second draft of the Illustrated Essay.
Topics to Revise	 Pupils should revise film language terminology; Camera Technique; Editing; Lighting; Mise-En-Scene and Sound. They need to also be able provide the purposes and meanings for certain techniques being used

	and whether they are Classic Hollywood Style, Formalist or Realist techniques.
Additional Information	Pupils will previously have chosen clips from their main practitioner. These clips should demonstrate techniques, which they can apply in their own work. Therefore they must also be aware how, where, when and why they will use the techniques in their film. This must be evident in their analysis.

Subject	Photography
Length of Examination	2 hours
Question Paper	Personal Investigation – Literacy element. Completion of essay.
Topics to Revise	Not required – All portfolio work must be with them for the exam, as they will need this to complete the essay.
Additional Information	Pupils will finalise the practical element of their Personal Investigation and produce their final outcome in January. They will then begin their Unit 3 externally set assignment on the 1st February. They will have a 15 hour exam in May to produce their final outcome for their externally set assignment.
